Are you more of a merciful person, a grace person or a justice person? Mercy (not getting what we deserve), grace (getting what we don't deserve) and justice (getting exactly what we deserve). How do you feel that you make those calls?

How can you use the response that Jesus gave the thief, "I tell you the truth, today you will be with Me in Paradise" to help in your choices regarding how to love people?

We each have choices in how we teach the gospel to the people in our lives. Jesus always spoke the truth in love.

Describe a time in your life when you chose truth in love rather than a harsh rebuke. (Disciplining your child, responding to an offense, correction of a friend). What was the result?
