II Timothy 3:16-17 (NLT)

All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.

The Bible is much more powerful than we give it credit. That power is because of its Source. What assurance does it give you to know it's "inspired by God"?

We sometimes use the Bible as a place to go for "good advice". Isn't the Bible more of a roadmap for living? What is the benefit for us to use the Word of God as He intended?

DIG DEEPER

There's wisdom in studying and living out the principles in God's Word. How have you seen the benefit of relying on the Bible when dealing with difficult situations in your life?

Romans 12:2 (NASB) "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect."

This scripture is so powerful! Renewing our minds goes against the current culture in every way. Culture says fit in, do what you think is right, there are no absolutes. How does today's culture find its way into your thinking?

Can you tell the difference in a day that starts off by reading and contemplating on God's Word as opposed to not taking that time? What are the effects His word has on you?
