Discussion Guide – One Day’s Wage: Convoy of Hope

Icebreakers

- Describe an experience you’ve had helping someone in need.

Grow Deeper

- Read [Galatians 6:7-9](#). The Law of the Harvest has eternal consequences. Describe a time or a season where you found this to be true.
- Read [Isaiah 58: 6-11](#). The question of sincere worship is raised in the first verses of chapter 58. God promises victory, healing, direction, protection, attention, guidance, provision, strength, and abundance. How can I claim these promises?
- Read [Deuteronomy 15:10](#). God’s love for the poor is a central, irreducible part of His character. How can we show compassion for those less fortunate?

Respond

- Read [Matthew 14:13-21](#). God loves to allow His people to participate in His plans. What impact can we have in the lives that Convoy of Hope touches?
- Rowling’s 4 levels show that the poorest in the world live on \$2 a day or less. Discuss the impact of improving these people’s lives by \$6 – moving them to level 2.
