Week 7- "What Matters": Marriage Matters

Recap the Highlights:

WHY MARRIAGE MATTERS

- Marriage is divinely CREATED by God as a revelation of His Grace.
- Marriage is uniquely DESIGNED as a Horizontal and Vertical Covenant.
- Marriage is expressly PURPOSED to make us <u>Holy</u> not merely Happy.
- Marriage is a spiritual covenant created by God for a man and a women. It is not a covenant fit for a season or culture.
- God created marriage. Man created and justified divorce.
- God never intended from the beginning for man to be alone he created a helper who was just right for him.
- Our choice to love our spouse <u>must</u> direct our feelings about them if not, our feelings will direct our choice concerning whether or not to love our spouse.
- Nothing is stronger or more stable than a Christ centered commitment of true love between a man and a women.
- The essence of marriage is a sacrificial commitment.
- The righteousness that grace demands is greater than the righteousness that law demands!

Now Dig Deeper:

- Marriage must return in our culture to be a central value. When people see our marriage they should see Jesus. What characteristics or values can you share that describe a Christ centered marriage?
- 2. Could your spouse be part of the answer of helping you be more like Christ? See Ephesians 5:31-32 and then discuss. Look up the scriptures below as a group for further discussion.

Respond & Pray:

- A. Your spouse is not responsible for YOUR level of commitment. Talk to God about making your current or future marriage a priority. There are different levels of commitment....where are you, really?
 - God first marriages = covenant of us
 - Self-centered marriages = covenant of me
- B. Pray over how can you partner with God to make <u>more</u> of your marriage. It starts with grace and commitment, seeking the supernatural love of God a "twice baked" covenant. Make God the head of your triangle!
