Sermon Discussion Guide

Series: Follow - Week 12

Palm Sunday: Follow Jesus to the cross...

Recap the Highlights:

- 1. "Before you get out of the tomb, you gotta go to the cross."
- 2. The most important part of Palm Sunday is the central characteristic which is that Jesus came on a march toward death to bring Salvation to all mankind.
- 3. The <u>Triumphal Entry</u> is what kicks off the week before the resurrection. Jesus went first to <u>cleanse the Temple</u>. He then <u>meets in the Upper Room</u>, where he has the <u>last supper</u> with the Disciples. Then He goes to the <u>Garden of Gethsemane</u> and prays throughout the night. He is then <u>arrested</u>, <u>tried</u>, <u>and crucified</u>.
- 4. What does following Jesus to the cross require of us?
 - a. **Triumphant Entry** Put to death any <u>hopes/expectations</u> we have in this fallen/temporal world in Exchange for the <u>rule</u> of God over all things.
 - b. **Cleansing of the Temple** Put to death our ability to get to God on our own or by our own acts/deeds of righteousness in Exchange for Christ's <u>imputed</u> righteousness and our daily <u>submission</u> to His Spirit.
 - c. Last Supper Put to death ...
 - i. pride, power and greed in Exchange for a new command He gives us to <u>Love</u> and a new dominion He invites us to experience <u>His Kingdom.</u>
 - ii. Our own expectations in Exchange for his perfect plan.
 - d. **Garden of Gethsemane** put to death our Will (no matter how noble it may seem) in Exchange for His Perfect Will.
 - e. **Arrest/Trial/Crucifixion** put to death Anything in our flesh/carnal appetites that remain In exchange for a new life raised up by the resurrection power of the Holy Spirit.

Now Dig Deeper:

- 1. What hopes or Expectations do you need to put to death?
- 2. Can you give an example of pride, power or greed that you have put to death and what has happened since then?
- 3. What has your plan looked like? Has there been a time when you had a plan, but God's plan ultimately looked different?
- 4. Can you imagine what those final hours with Jesus might have looked like for the disciples had they been able to stay awake with him?
- 5. As we prepare for Easter this weekend, what have we learned about the passion week that will help prepare even us more?
