Sermon Discussion Guide

Series: Following Jesus into Relationships Sermon: Gaining Jesus' Perspective on Work Relationships

Recap the Highlights: Matthew 20:1-16

- 1. How do we see our "Work"?
 - a. We must see our work as being ordained by God to develop the Fruits of the Spirit **IN** us and display God's glory **THROUGH** us toward others!
- 2. How do we see **Others**?
 - a. vs. 12, "Those people worked only one hour, and yet you've paid them just as much as you paid us who worked all day in the scorching heat."
- 3. How do we see **<u>Ourselves</u>**?
 - a. vs. 11, "When they received their pay, they protested (grumbled NASB) to the owner."
- 4. How do we see **Jesus** in relationship to our work environment?
 - a. vs. 11 "When they received it, they grumbled **at** the landowner..."
 - b. Vs. 12 "These who were hired last worked only one hour,' they said, 'and **you** have **made them equal to us** who have born the burden of the work and the heat of the day."

The origin of our discontentment is not what someone else has - so stop **Comparing**.

The origin of our discontentment is not what you don't have - so stop **Complaining**.

You'll never be satisfied with <u>WHAT</u> you have until you are content with <u>WHO</u> you are in Christ.

Now Dig Deeper:

- 1. Considering that 80% of Americans are dissatisfied with their jobs, What do you feel is the core of the issue here? Are you one of these people?
- 2. Talk about a time where your character grew as a result of going through a challenging time in your career.
- 3. Are there ways that you currently compare yourself to others? How can you work to improve yourself so that you don't compare yourself as much?
- 4. How can you intentionally work to improve your perspective about work and the people you work with?
