Series: Following Jesus into Relationships Sermon: Following Jesus in Marriage

Recap the Highlights:

Marriage is not about making you **Happy**, but making you **Holy**.

Anchor your expectations of marriage to...

- 1. To the **Covenant** of Marriage.
 - a. "The Honeymoon" stage

 - b. "The Party's Over" stagec. "The Best is Yet to Be" stage
- 2. **Cultivate** your Marriage relationship
 - a. You will always harvest what you plant. Galatians 6:7b NLT
 - i. **Time**
 - ii. **Hard Work**
 - iii. **Communicate/Listen**
 - iv. Serve your spouse
- 3. Biblical **Love**
 - a. 1 Corinthians 13:1-7
 - b. One of the most obvious ways that Biblical love is demonstrated is through Forgiveness - For God so loved the world that he gave/forgave.
 - c. Colossians 3:13 Make allowances for each other's faults and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.

- 1. What was the most revealing part of this message for you? Why do you think that was?
- 2. What expectations did you come into your marriage with? Do you feel you had any unfair expectations? If you aren't married, what can you learn from this now?
- 3. Talk about the differences between a contract and a covenant and what it really means to you.

- 5. What are some faults that you know you need allowances for?
