Series: Built to Last Sermon: The Foundation

Recap the Highlights:

What do I need to create a home that is built to last?

- 1. A home built to last must have a good **architect**.
 - a. The institution of family was God's idea.
 - b. The family works best when it is built according to His design.
 - c. The family is a microcosm of the broader family of God.
 - d. That family is meant to propagate the Father's agenda into the world.
- 2. A home built to last must have a strong foundation.
 - a. God's Word is the ultimate foundation of the Family!
 - i. A foundation is **essential** You cannot build a house that will last without a foundation!
 - ii. A foundation is **consequential** It affects every area of the house.
 - iii. A faulty foundation is **fixable** But it requires a temporary setback for correction.

Now Dig Deeper:

- 1. Most of us had a plan for our lives? How did it differ from the one God had for you? Can you think of a time when you thought your plan was better than the one God had for you?
- 2. The enemy loves to attack a Godly marriage/family. Discuss a time when your family was attacked and how you were able to overcome this? Talk about ways to be proactive in preventing these spiritual warfare attacks.
- 3. Discuss the difference between treating the symptoms and fixing the root cause or foundation.
- 4. When fixing a faulty foundation, Pastor Michael stated that it requires a temporary setback. Has there been a time when this has happened to you? Has there been a time when you avoided this by not fixing the foundation?
