Series: Legacy

Sermon: The Legacy we leave the Next Generation - Investments we make now.

Recap the Highlights:

The LEGACY we leave the Next Generation will point to the INVESTMENTS we are making here and now!

I Timothy 6:17-19 (NLT)

What is the nature of your investments

- 1. **Intention** or **Sporadic** (vs 18)
 - a. If we don't deliberately decide ahead of time that we're going to be rich in our good deeds and generous, then it's just like anything else we don't plan for we will not be able to give our best, but our leftovers.
- 2. Steward or Owner (vs 17)
 - a. <u>Owner</u> possessed it legally; gives direction exclusively on how it's used and cared for; is responsible for creating the money/possessions AND for ensuring its continued supply.
 - b. **Steward** is entrusted with another's wealth or property and charged with the responsibility of managing it in the owner's best interest.
- 3. **Eternal** or **Temporal** (vs. 19)

The tithe is a spiritual investment instrument, whereby God invites us to participate by faith in His Kingdom Legacy.

- Teaches us to intentionally and consistently put God **FIRST!**
- Reminds us of His **Ownership**.
- Invites us into His **Provision**.

Now Dig Deeper:

- 1. Discuss what the tithe is and what the tithe is not as a group.
- 2. The purpose of Tithing is not to raise <u>money</u>, but to raise our <u>faith</u>. Discuss how this statement resonates with you.
- 3. Pastor Patrick stated that we tip those who serve us, but we tithe those who we serve. Discuss how putting God first fulfills our command to tithe and what that actually looks like for us.
