THEME

ROOTED

High School Retreat is more than just a weekend getaway—it's an intentional space for students to put down spiritual roots that will sustain them long after the weekend ends. This retreat is not just about having a moment with God, but about learning how to walk with Him daily.

This year, our theme is **ROOTED: Building a Faith That Lasts**. We will be focusing on the spiritual disciplines that help believers stay connected to Jesus—prayer, God's Word, worship, and community. These are not religious habits; they are lifelines that keep our faith alive and growing. Just like a tree draws strength from its roots, students will learn how their relationship with Jesus grows through consistent connection with Him.
