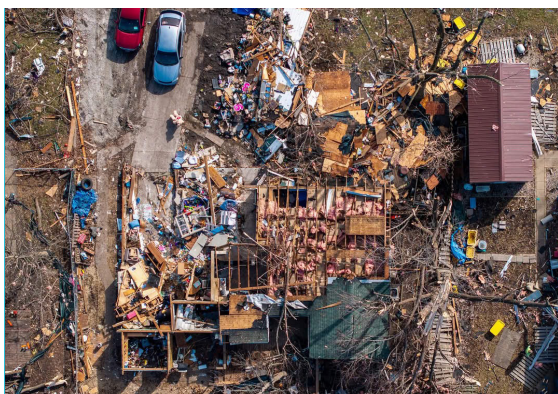

## Lane Overview

Through Convoy of Hope, our National Outreach Lane helps provide care to our nation when crisis hits. Convoy sends truckloads of food and relief supplies from coast to coast, delivering goods used for events and disaster responses. Partnering with Association of Related Churches (ARC) since 2007, Compel helps plant life-giving churches across our nation.

## Lane Highlights



This summer Convoy of Hope is responding to natural disasters around the world, from continued U.S. tornado and storm response in the Midwest to earthquake devastation across the globe in Venezuela.

After a tornado impacted the Streator, Illinois area, Convoy served alongside local partners to distribute essential relief supplies, including tarps, totes, water, hygiene kits, and other critical items. These items are huge for residents as they rebuild.



Convoy is also serving in Kansas, where a derecho impacted several communities. In Salina, Kansas — which experienced straight-line winds up to 113 mph — Convoy is working with local partners and emergency managers to cut trees and clear brush for impacted residents.

# New Vision Projects

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## Convoy of Hope - Disaster Relief

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Now that a core team of men from Compel received Disaster Response training from Convoy's headquarters in June 2025, the next step is to create a Disaster Relief Team at Compel, so we are ready to partner with Convoy in deploying relief teams in our region when disaster hits.

Compel would also like to partner with Convoy to host a new Regional Distribution Center in North Mississippi. Dream Center Director Jenna Kern and Pastor Patrick Conrad are discussing plans with Convoy to begin receiving trucks of proteins and produce for distribution in our area!

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## Convoy of Hope

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Convoy of Hope is a faith-based organization with a driving passion to feed the world through children's feeding initiatives, community outreach, and disaster response. In partnership with local churches, businesses, civic organizations, and government agencies, Convoy strategically offers help and hope to communities around the world.

## ARC (Association of Related Churches)

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Since 2000, the mission of ARC has been to train and resource church planters in starting new churches. New church plants and existing churches that partner with ARC in planting churches are legally autonomous, independently led, separately operated, and solely accountable to their leadership, independent of the ARC organization. ARC is grateful to churches like Compel for their love of Jesus and for joining in the mission to plant new churches!

In 2025, **55** new churches were launched across **22** states and **8** countries. More than **20,000** people attended these launch day services, and on those days **1,626** people made a decision to follow Jesus! Currently **55** couples are preparing to plant churches this year!

Support ARC Launch events, held several times across the nation each year to train U.S. church planters.

Monthly Support: **\$1,000 (\$12,000 annually)**

## John 3:16 Ministries

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Helping men and women overcome drugs and alcohol through the power of Jesus. In this program, participants have structured daily schedule which include Bible studies, a physical work day, exercise, chores and group meals. An extensive variety of work areas are offered for the men, from carpentry to auto mechanic/bodywork to off-camp service at various locations. In the first few weeks of 2026, **27** residents have already given their lives to Christ!

Monthly Support: **\$500 (\$6,000 annually)**
